Community, Nature, and Connection - Local amenities like Ramsey Library and One Leisure Centre help people stay active, while nearby green spaces such as Ramsey Heights Nature Reserve offer peaceful spots for sensory exploration. Accessible bus routes, including the RH5, connect residents to surrounding towns, supporting independence and community involvement.


Co-Produced, Person-Led Support - Shaped by people with lived experience, we build care plans around each person's strengths and goals - like supporting someone with a passion for art to lead classes.

Expert, Caring Team - All our staff are trained in Positive Behaviour Support (PBS) and Proact-SCIPr-UK. Each person we support has a tailored PBS plan, with input from our in-house PBS Practitioners.



Two apartments are located on the ground-floor and two on the first-floor, accessed via a widened central staircase. Each apartment includes:

- **One or two flexible rooms:** Use as bedrooms or as a bedroom with a private living space
- **Wet-room bathroom:** Complete with toilet and sink
- **Self-contained kitchen:** Fully private and practical for independent living
- **Access to a shared garden:** A welcoming outdoor space for everyone to enjoy
